- Introduction: Whereas Miami University (ÒUniversityÓ) recognizes its Leadership Commitment that it has the responsibility to Ochallenge and upport thers Éto appreciate and resperuman dignity and diversity, is incumbent upon the collegeto not contribute to the illegal mistreatment of workers. In addition, the UniversityÖ Sode of Student Conductates that the University embraces the rights and values of freespeech peaceable assembly, make constructive criticism; and promote an environment that espects differences culture, gender, religion, race, and bility. The University expects it sicensees (defined elow) to conduct their busines in a manner consistent with, and follow who place standards hat adhere to the guidelines established this code of conduct. The University should take approactive stance aspossible to investigate the companies deals with and to seek out and promote standards in Section IV. As the verifier of compliance, the University should received at a staken company controlled monitoring but will rely upon the Workers Rights Consortium (WRC) for monitoring efforts.
- II. Notice: This code shallapply to all registered mark licensees of the University. Throughout this code the term Olicensees hall include all persons oentities who have mered written licensing agreement with University to manufacture products bearithen name registered marks and/or images of the University. Additionally, this codes hall apply to all of the licensee Os contractors. Throughout his code the term Ocontractor fall include each contractor, subcontract wendor, or manufacture that is engaged in manufacturing process at results in finished product for the consumer. OManufacturing rocess shall include assembly and packaging.

As acondition of being permitted oproduce and/osell licensed products bearing the name, registered marks and/or images of the University, each license must comply with this code and ensure that its contractors comply with is code. All license of an other actors are equired to adher to this code within ix months of notification of the code and as equired in applicable license agreements.
